Results reach \$60,000 top price

RED bulls just pipped the greys at the post at this year's Rockhampton Brahman Week Sale in the price average stakes, averaging \$6638 for 377 bulls sold from the 384 offered, to gross \$2.5 million.

Three studs dominated the red Brahman line-up in the top 14 bulls of the entire sale, while a host of other studs exceeded the sale average with their quality offerings.

A \$60,000 bull, Rockley 2391 (ET), offered by the Kirk

family's Rockley Brahman, Bajool, topped the sale, with the stud accounting for three of the top 10 priced bulls of the entire sale.

The 29-month-old, 922kg bull, sired by Tartrus Redmount 2365 (ET), was bought by Cameron and Liz Cogill, Double C Red Brahman, Gogango, who were impressed with his looks, thickness and figures which included rip and rump fat scans of 8mm and 6mm respectively, and eye muscle area of 121sq cm.

By the end of their run through the sale ring, vendors Chris, Sally and Ashley Kirk, had set the sale benchmark, selling a total of 15 bulls for \$271,000 and average

of \$18,066.

Among the Rockley bulls, 22-month-old Rockley 2486 sold for \$32,500 to Gipsy Plains Cattle Company, Cloncurry, and just a few minutes later, 27-month-old Rockley 2396 (ET) (another son of Tartrus Redmount 2365) sold for \$32,000 to Creek Farm, Alpha.

Second top price of \$35,000 for a red bull was paid twice – the first time for 35-month-old Wandilla Zulu 544/8, sold by Lee and Gillian Collins, Wandilla Brahman, Marlborough, to Brett Nobbs, Nobbs Cattle Co, Duaringa, in partnership with Brian Hughes, Lanes Creek Brahman, Georgetown.

Utai (AI) and out of Wandilla Jean, had rump and rib scans of 8mm and 7mm respectively and an EMA of 133sq cm.

In total, Wandilla sold 22 bulls to average \$8818.

The \$35,000 mark for a red bull was again hit the next day when 21-month-old Muan A Indus (AI), offered by Len and Peter Gibbs, Muan Brahman, Biggenden, was bought by Greenback Investments, Clermont.

The bull was a polled son of BB Mr Stingray 10/0 (Imp US), out of a cow by

Tartrus Redmount.

Muan also surpassed the sale average, selling 16 bulls to average \$8687.

The Kandoona line of red bulls also claimed high-priced honours at the sale, with Bevan and Liz and Reade and Jill Radel, Kandoona Red Brahman, Injune, selling two bulls for \$30,000 each among their offering of 21 bulls which averaged \$9500 in total.

The 23-month-old Kandoona Mace (AI) (ET) was bought for \$30,000 by Brett Nobbs, Nobbs Cattle Co, Duaringa, in partner-

ship with Brian Hughes, Lanes Creek Brahman, Georgetown.

The price was repeated just two lots later when 23-month-old Kandoona Magistrate (AI) (ET) was bought by David and Julie McCamley, Palmalmal, Dingo.

Both bulls were sired by HK Magnetic (Imp US), and out of Kandoona cows.

Mark and Tarsh Allen, Kariboe Valley Stud, Thangool, also hit \$30,000 when they sold 23-month-old Kariboe Valley Impact (AI) to Billabong Partnership, Moura.

The bull, sired by Mr Winchester Magnum 999 (Imp US) (ET) was the Allens first 999 bull to be sold.

In total, Kariboe Valley sold seven red bulls to average \$9857.

A \$27,000 top was reached by the Olsen family's Neslo Stud, Wandooan, after selling 33-month-old Neslo A 2391 Burton De Manso to Riverside Pastoral Company, Nebo.

Neslo sold a total of six bulls for an average of \$10,916.

Kearin and Beth Streeter's Palmvale Red Brahman, Marlborough, were also right on target with their line of bulls sired by Mr Winchester Magnum 999 (Imp US) (ET).
